## WHY IS SAFE MEDICATION DISPOSAL IMPORTANT FOR PUBLIC HEALTH?

Proper disposal of unused  
medication saves lives and  
protects the environment.

- Unused or expired medication can lead to accidental poisoning, overdose, and abuse.
- Unused medication thrown in the trash can be retrieved and abused or illegally sold.
- Unused medication that is flushed contaminates the water supply.

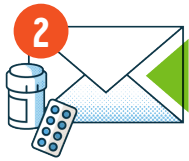

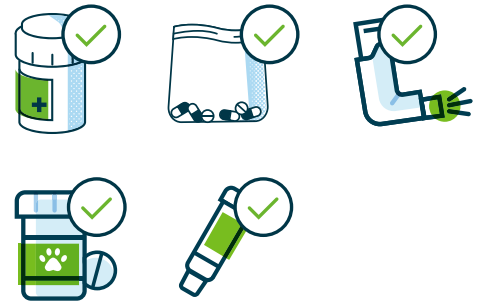
### TAKE-BACK EVENTS

## WHAT CAN YOU DISPOSE OF IN A KIOSK OR MAILBACK ENVELOPE?



### ACCEPTED:

**Medication in any dosage form, except for those listed below, in their original container or sealed bag.\***

\*If transferring medication to a sealed bag, please be sure to recycle all remaining packaging

### NOT ACCEPTED:

**Herbal remedies, vitamins, supplements, cosmetics, other personal care products, empty medical devices or medical devices that do not contain drugs, batteries, mercury-containing thermometers, sharps, illegal drugs, and pet pesticide products.**
